










#### Devos: Ecc 3 (Sun), 11 (Mon)

- Find a quiet, undistracted spot
- Settle your heart, pray to be receptive to God's Word
- Read straight through: reactions, questions
- Re-read, now deeper: context, xrefs, word study
  - Outline? Why is this passage in the Bible?
  - What does God want to communicate?
- Re-read, now slower: pause, silence, listen
  - What is God saying to you?
  - Pray your response to God
- Re-read straight through to retain it
